VOLUNTEER BAKERS, RICHMOND LOCATION

The Vineyard Community & Richmond Foodbank are looking for new Volunteer Bakers to join our tight-knit community.

As a charity, we run crisis and social inclusion services from six locations across the Borough of Richmond, including our foodbank services and our Crisis Drop-In service. Every day, we help individuals overcome personal crises and reconnect with society.

We are incredibly proud of the impact we make to people's lives. Across the 2022-2023 tax year, we were able to house nearly 70 people, serve over 11,000 breakfasts and provide medical support to more than 150 people via our community nursing team. Additionally, we provided emergency food aid to over 5350 people across our 6 foodbank sites in 2023.

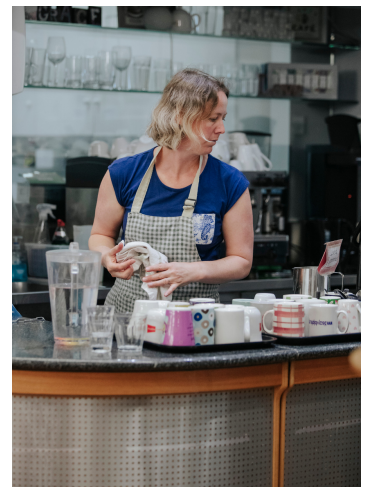
THE ROLE

As a Volunteer Baker, you will be using your cooking powers to become a force for good in the local community. Nothing brings people together like food, and a crucial part of our service is making people feel welcome and at home in our space.

Your duties will include:

- Baking delicious homemade goods, such as cakes, cookies and brownies
- Dropping off your baked goods to Vineyard Community Centre weekly at a designated time, ideally between 8am-9am
- Bringing in name labels for your goods, including noting down the ingredient list and any common allergens.

Please note that we are happy to reimburse baking materials when you provide a valid receipt of purchase. Donated cakes will be served across our Foodbank and Crisis Drop-In services to lift the spirits of those in need.
